Join Ealing Wildlife Group at the beautiful Costons Lane Nature Reserve. The Nature Reserve is open to the public every 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month so come on down and relax in the natural paradise of Costons Lane Nature Reserve. There's a bird hide, several ponds and wetlands, a small wood, a wildlife garden and a sunny deck to relax on and have some tea. Location: Costons Lane Nature Reserve (The gate is to the right of 61 Clifton Rd, Greenford, UB6 8SP on Ruislip Road E).

Hanwell Zoo (formerly known as Brent Lodge Park Animal Centre) is popular attraction located in Brent Lodge Park in Hanwell, London W7. The park itself, known local as the "Bunny Park" has been home to a centre for all ages to see and get up close to a wide range of animals including mammals, birds and reptiles since 1975. Other facilities within the park also include a maze made up of 2000 yews, a café, play area and free (limited) car parking.
